IN A NUTSHELL: INFORMATION ON STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS AT ROWE

Here is an overview of how standards and specifications are indicated on our products.



1. Approvals section:

For the specifications listed here, the respective vehicle manufacturers (OEMs) have explicitly approved the ROWE product following a testing procedure. In doing so, the vehicle manufacturer confirms that the formulation used by ROWE meets all quality requirements.

2. Specifications section:

This page lists all the specifications for which the product is suitable. The formulation used by ROWE has been tested by independent testing laboratories and fully meets the requirements of the OEMs. No additional approval from the vehicle manufacturer is required.

3. ROWE Recommendations section:

We recommend this product for the specifications listed here based on internal testing, our own experience (on the road or on the racetrack), and/or findings obtained in collaboration with external partners and independent testing laboratories. No approval procedures are available for the specifications listed here.

Regardless of whether a specification is listed under **"Approvals," "Specifications,"** or **"ROWE recommendations,"** the ROWE product is ideally suited for that specification.

ROWE is liable, in accordance with statutory warranty claims, to ensure that the product is suitable for the listed specification, regardless of which of the three categories the specification falls under. When selecting a ROWE product, please always ensure that, in addition to the specification required for the specific application, the specific viscosity grade required is also selected. This is prominently displayed on ROWE products in the color-coded section of the label or directly below the product name (e.g. 5W-30).
